

# Radiator Installation Preparation Checklist

To ensure a smooth and efficient installation process, there are a few important details and preparations we need your help with. This checklist is to ensure that when our team arrives, they can get straight to work without any delays and complete the job successfully.

Please let us know if any of the points on this checklist will pose an issue prior to installation so we can adjust accordingly.

## Check the following before your scheduled installation

- Are the areas where the radiators are going to be installed clear of building materials and furniture that might need to be moved?
- Are the walls painted and floor coverings installed?
  - *Flooring installers can sometimes damage radiators during their work. If flooring hasn't been installed, it is possible for the radiators to be unclipped from the wall to allow other works to be done as required.*
- Will the power be on, so radiators can be tested and set up?

### For plug-in installation:

- Are there power points located close to where each radiator will be installed?

### For hardwired installation:

- Have Hardwiring Kits been installed by an electrician where each radiator will be installed?
  - *Hardwiring kits are an optional accessory that can be purchased from us to allow for simple hardwired installation.*

### For Unisenza Plus Smart Home Gateway installation :

- Is there working Wi-Fi connected to the house?
  - *If so, please provide login information on the day to our installer.*
